RUMFORD-MEXICO SEWERAGE DISTRICT TRUSTEE MEETING May 3, 2023

Public hearing called to order by Chairman Gautreau at 5;30 PM.

Present: Supt. Arsenault, Blais, Robinson, Ulmer, Palmer, Murphy, Daigle, Gautreau

Members of public in attendance: Randy & Carrol Glover and Alicia Conn, Dixfield Town Manager.

- 1. Background on L.D. 1911: Supt. Arsenault gave a brief summary of L.D. 1911 that the Governor signed into law in June of 2022.
- 2. Septage receiving rate increase July 2022. Supt. Arsenault explained why the rates were increased in July of 2022. The estimated cost of landfilling was to be in excess of \$300,000. The rate increase was to help offset the landfill costs.
- 3. Septage receiving rate revision May 2023: Supt. Arsenault explained the rate decrease for septage receiving. The district has a better understanding of the sludge disposal costs.
- 4. Board action: Motion by Murphy, seconded by Palmer to accept the septage receiving rate decrease presented by Supt. Arsenault. Motion passed unanimously. Septage from in district will decrease from \$136/1,000 gallons to \$80/1,000 gallons. Septage from out of district will decrease from \$204/1,000 gallons to \$140,1,000 gallons. Holding from in district will decrease from \$30/1,000 gallons to \$15/1,000 gallons. Holding from out of district will remain unchanged at \$75/1,000 gallons. Chemical toilet waste will decrease from \$100/1,000 gallons to \$50/1,000 gallons.
- 5. Adjournment: Motion by Daigle, seconded by Ulmer to adjourn at 5:37 pm. Motion passed.
